OWNER'S OPEN FORUM

Jay Haygood asked if BMSA is in support of the potential Metcalf soil treatment facility. Is there anything BMSA can do to express the community members concerns regarding the possible toxic chemicals that could be emitted into the air.

Director Arrington stated that there will be heavy metals in the soil. The Metcalf brothers will have to leave 2 feet of clean soil on top of the bentanite soil once the project is completed.

Director Hill stated that the pad in Parachute was also used as a soil treatment facility. There were no odors noticed in The Fairways from that facility.

Mr. Haygood stated that the next meeting is scheduled for November. If the Board is going to write a letter expressing any concerns, if possible, have the letter completed before the next meeting.

CALL TO ORDER

Director Lammey called the meeting to order at 9:14 am.

Director Lammey excused absent Board members Bernita Grove, Greg Davidson and Brad Hoy.

Director McCurdy disclosed that she is a Board member of the Battlement Mesa Metropolitan District.

Director Lammey disclosed that a company he owns is under contract with the BMSA to provided covenant protection services and newsletter services.

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Director Fletcher disclosed that he is a Board member of the Battlement Mesa Metropolitan District and the Parachute/Battlement Mesa Park and Recreation District.

Director Short disclosed that a company he owns is under contract with the BMSA to provide landscape maintenance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Director McCurdy and seconded by Director Hill to approve the September 17, 2013 minutes as amended. The motion carried unanimously.

DEVELOPER REPORT

Declarant Fletcher reported that 23 homes at the RV Park have been sold. The buyer has begun moving the homes out.

NEW BUSINESS

Daycare at 98 Tamarisk Trail

A motion was made by Director McCurdy and seconded by Director Koning to approve the daycare at 98 Tamarisk Trail contingent on the proper license and insurance. The motion carried unanimously.

2014 Preliminary Budget

Director Koning asked if the covenant protection officer job warrants a \$20,000 pay check. She feels all contracts need to go out to bid. Director Hill agreed.

Director Arrington stated that the bid from Elk Peaks Consulting for covenant enforcement, website and newsletter contracts total \$32,400 per year. Could BMSA hire an employee to do all of these things instead of having a contractor.





Director Lammey stated that he doesn't track his time by hour while working on covenant violations. He is always looking for covenant violations.

Director Lammey stated that he is fine with putting the contracts out to bid.

Declarant Fletcher stated that it is not a good presentation on a public relations level for the Board of Directors to have Director Lammey as the President of the BMSA Board and also the covenant violation officer. Declarant Fletcher feels that the covenant violation officer position is held against Director Lammey.

Director Shepherd stated that these items don't need to be approved to approve the 2014 preliminary budget. These are contract issues that can be discussed at a later time.

Director Arrington stated that the Finance Committee met with Mr. Rippy to review the 2014 preliminary budget. The committee felt the budget looks appropriate.

Director Koning stated that the Board has spent considerable funds out of our reserve funds this year for the LED lighting project and the trails overlay project. The dues have not been raised in many years. The Board needs to decide where we are comfortable as to the amount of money in the reserve fund.

Mr. Rippy stated that the projected year end balance of the reserve fund will be about \$720,000. Except to finish the LED lighting project, there are no large projects proposed to be done in 2014.

After further discussion the Board agreed to email any questions regarding the 2014 preliminary budget to Mr. Rippy.

A motion was made by Director Shepherd and seconded by Director McCurdy to approve the 2014 preliminary budget as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Collection of Unpaid Assessments

After discussion the Board agreed to have Mr. Rippy and Mrs. Martin review the resolution and report back to the Board at the November meeting.

A motion was made by Director Shepherd and seconded by Director Hill to have Mr. Rippy and Director Arrington write a letter to the Garfield County Planning Department outlining BMSA's concerns regarding the potential soil treatment facility on the Metcalf property. The letter will be distributed to all Board members via email for review prior to being signed by Director Lammey and mailed. The motion carried unanimously.

HEARINGS

Declarant Fletcher presided the meeting at 11:40 for the hearing process.

A motion was made by Director McCurdy and seconded by Director Hill to fine the owners of 12 W Bonanza Place \$25 per day for two weeks then \$50 per day for two weeks then \$75 per day for two weeks then \$100 per day until all the weeds and tall grass are removed from the entire property. The motion carried with Director Lammey abstaining.

A motion was made by Director McCurdy and seconded by Director Koning to go onto the property at 116 Queen City Circle to mow the weeds and grass. Also, remove the Christmas lights, remove all debris from front and back yard, and repair the fence. All charges accrued will be doubled and charged back to the account. The motion carried with Director Lammey abstaining.

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A motion was made by Director McCurdy and seconded by Director Hill to go onto the property at 95 E Tamarack Circle to mow the weeds and grass and remove the weeds in the seams of the concrete driveway. All charges accrued will be doubled and charged back to the account. The motion carried with Director Lammey abstaining.

A motion was made by Director Koning and seconded by Director McCurdy to leave all fines in place at 39 Goldfield Court, but take no further action at this time. The motion carried unanimously with Director Lammey abstaining.

A motion was made by Director Koning and seconded by Director McCurdy to go onto the property at 102 Sagemont Circle to mow the weeds and grass and remove the dead trees. All charges accrued will be doubled and charged back to the account. The motion carried with Director Lammey abstaining.

A motion was made by Director Koning and seconded by Director McCurdy to leave all fines in place at 188 Lodgepole Circle, but take no further action at this time. The motion carried unanimously with Director Lammey abstaining.

A motion was made by Director Short and seconded by Director McCurdy to fine the owners of 114 Lodgepole Circle \$25 per day for two weeks then \$50 per day for two weeks then \$75 per day for two weeks then \$100 per day until the weeds and tall grass re removed from the entire property. The motion carried with Director Lammey abstaining.

October 15, 2013 Report on Financial Documents

For September 2013

Operating Accounts

The August 2013 financial documents are similar to recent months and have been submitted to the Financial Committee by our Property Manager. Copies have been included in your packets. These have been reviewed. The financial documents cover the ninth month of our financial year. They appear complete and accurate and comply with accepted financial accounting standards. There are no entries that are unusual and the accounts that exceed budget amounts by significant amounts are balanced out by the items of large under runs.

The year to date data reflects the actual Operating Revenues under ran the Budget amounts by \$101.51 and expenses under ran the budget by \$55,224.07. This reflects a net of \$23,956.56 or \$55,122.56 under budget.

Reserve Accounts Review

We also reviewed the Reserve Accounts. Although there is a significant dollar difference between budget and actual amounts, they reflect pending payment for trail replacement and transfer from operating to reserve accounts.




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

Current Focus

Additional pages have been added to the KSUN Community Radio section and all of the pages have been revised in order to allow KSUN to promote their advertisers on the KSUN webpages. As previously reported KSUN has a new domain name: www.KSUNcommunityradio.org. You can get to the KSUN site by logging into the Battlement Mesa site then clicking on "News, Media and Events," then clicking on "KSUN." (KSUN is also generating a quarterly newsletter. Please contact me if you would like to be added to the Newsletter distribution list). During September, there were 9,768 visits to the Battlement Mesa website, 30,011 page views, and 1,223,045 hits on the site. (Definition of Hit: A hit represents a request to your web site for a file such as an image, a web page, or a CGI script. One web page may contain several related resources, and as a result, a visitor viewing one web page may trigger several hits.)
- Newsletter Our newsletter distribution list stands at 430. Please encourage people to sign up for this newsletter. (Top of the Home page of website). The September newsletter achieved an open rate of 45.4% (equal to last month) and a 5.7% click through rate. The October Newsletter will be distributed on October 15th or, worse case, 16th.
- <u>Showcase Positive Lifestyle</u> The 2013 Insiders' Guide has been distributed. The new Insiders' Guide is 32 pages and will be added to <u>www.BattlementMesaColorado.com</u>.
- Facebook Our facebook "friend" list seems stuck at 113 of which only 28 (so far) say they "like us." If you have a facebook account, please join our friend list and, encourage others to do so.


Overview:

2014 Budget: I have prepared the 2014 preliminary budget for the Board's review and reviewed it with the Finance Committee prior to the Board meeting. I have prepared line item worksheets on those items newly added or in which the line item amount has significant change from the previous year. I have also included some line item capital expenditures in the Reserve Fund that have been discussed over the course of the last year. The Board will need to review these items and then prioritize the amount of funds if any that should be allocated to each or additional projects that should be added.

Rainbow Trail Trees: I have received several calls over the past couple of weeks about tree limbs overhanging homes and causing damage to roofs. The trees are located in the green belt along Rainbow Trail and are considered BMSA trees. I have contacted B&B Tree Service to begin trimming these trees as soon as possible.

LED Retrofit Project: LED retrofits to street lights have now been completed in Battlement Creek Village, Stone Ridge and Monument Creek Village. Tamarisk Village and Tamarisk Meadows are scheduled to be completed next.

Stone Ridge Entry Monument: As I reported in last months report the sign (letters) on the Stone Ridge entry monument were replaced with aluminum lettering as the previous plastic letters had been vandalized. Approximately two weeks after the installation of the new letters vandals pried several of the new letters from the monument and stole them. I have contacted Micro Plastics to see if they have a different solution or application to solve this problem.

Open Space – Stone Quarry Road: The two "No Dumping Signs" have been installed in the BMSA open space along Stone Quarry Road where residents have been dumping tree limbs, grass clipping and other landscape maintenance materials. A 40 yard dumpster has been placed at this location and the materials will be loaded and hauled away.
