


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

# BMSA Board of Directors Meeting April 21, 2015 Associated Governments of Northwest Colorado Committee Update

#### Overview:

The AGNC last met on March 18, 2015 in Battlement Mesa, Colorado at the Grand Valley Fire Protection District. Both Sara McCurdy and I attended. The next meeting is scheduled for April 15, 2015 and will be held in in Rifle, most likely at or near the airport. Although the AGNC is still waiting on confirmation, Governor Hickenlooper is expected to attend a portion of the meeting. The agenda for the April meeting has not yet been published.

The two guest speakers for the March 18th meeting were:

- Trisha Korbas, US Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration.

As expected, our weekly AGNC legislative conference calls have attracted many participants, including some from Delta which (currently) is not in the AGNC member area. The calls are held on Friday at noon and usually last about an hour.

The AGNC continues to be very proactive on several issues and will no doubt continue efforts to either support or challenge legislation that will be proposed in Colorado's 2015 Legislature.

# **Manager Report**

<u>Street Drainage Improvements</u>: Garfield County completed the concrete drainage pan improvements in the Tamarisk Meadows last week. The location of the improvements were at the intersection of Mineral Springs Circle, Thunderberg Trail, Horizon Circle and the streets of Goldfield Court and Bent Creek Circle.

**N. Battlement Parkway Repairs**: The Battlement Mesa Metropolitan District has completed the repaving of N. Battlement Parkway which was caused from a waterline rupture in late November of 2014. Due to winter weather conditions the repaving could not occur prior.

<u>Community Fence Improvements</u>: I have completed discussions with a fencing contractor and received a quote on the costs to power wash and stain the existing cedar picket fences. The proposed cost to power wash and stain, including stain material, is \$2.25 per lineal foot. The BMSA maintains approximately 26,000 lineal feet of the cedar picket fences. The cost to do all the fences based upon the \$2.25 per lineal foot is approximately \$60,000.

My suggestion would be to do a portion of the fences initially and then evaluate the aesthetics and identify any problems or issues prior to moving forward with the remainder of the fencing. I would recommend starting with the fences that are most visible to the public along Battlement Parkway and Stone Quarry Road. Thos sections would include Battlement Creek Village, Willow Creek Village and Monument Creek Village, Saddleback Village and the Tamarisk Village areas. The lineal footage for these areas is 11,620 and the cost would be \$26,145.

**Spencer Trail**: I have received two estimates for the construction of the soft trail improvements along Spencer Parkway the land surface is to be graded, sprayed with weed killer and then surfaced with three inches of 3/4" road base. The 1<sup>st</sup> proposal is for \$35,350 and the second proposal is for \$26,450.

**Street Sweeping**: The first sweeping of the residential streets was completed this month. All of the villages including the sub-associations were included in the sweeping. A second sweeping will occur in the next few weeks. The second sweeping does not include the sub-associations.
