#### CALL TO ORDER

Director McCurdy called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

### Discussion of the request of the BCC to request our Oil & Gas Local Designated Official to request a hearing with the COGCC regarding the approval of the drilling pad B in Battlement Mesa

Doug Saxton with the BCC stated that the Garfield County Commissioners approved the BMC B well pad which includes 24 wells. The COGCC has approved the BMC B pad which includes 25 wells. The extra well is for a type 2 injection well. The BCC would like the BMSA to have our oil & gas local designated official write a letter to the COGCC requesting a hearing to have the injection well and associated facilities be removed from the BMC B pad approval.

After much discussion, a motion was made by Director Keller and seconded by Director Arrington to have BMSA's Oil & Gas local designated official write a letter to the COGCC requesting a hearing to remove the injection well and associated facilities from URSA's approved BMC B pad. The motion failed with a vote of 4 for the motion and 7 against the motion. Directors Arrington, Keller, Wyman and Shepherd voted for the motion, Directors McCurdy, Johnson, Toomey and Risk voted against the motion and by proxy Declarant Schmela and Gallegos and Director Hoy voted against the motion.
