MANAGER REPORT

Mr. Rippy reported that he received a proposal from Eric Short from Lush Green Landscapes for installing a soft trail along Battlement Parkway where Holy Cross just installed a new main electrical line. The proposal came in at \$19,000 but does not include additional dirt work that would need to be completed by the concrete drainage structure.

Mr. Rippy reported that he has been working with Mary Lee Mohrlang from the Inspire Initiative Program. The program has a \$5,000 grant that they would like to use on a project in Battlement Mesa. Mr. Rippy stated that they have agreed to improve the cross walk from the Willow Park apartments to the new Kum & Go across Battlement Parkway. Mr. Rippy has contacted Garfield County to start a process of approval for the crosswalk improvements.

DEVELOPER REPORT

Declarant Schmela reported that the COGCC has approved URSA to drill the D pad within the Battlement Mesa PUD and URSA is planning to start work on that pad by the fall of 2016.

Declarant Schmela reported that there is a new power line going in from the back 9 on the golf course to Rifle.

Declarant Schmela reported that AIG took over ownership of the RV Park, Tamarisk Village Pads, Modular Home Park and the Willow Ridge apartments as of July 13, 2016. BMC has entered into contract with AIG's property management company to continue running the day to day operations. Declarant Schmela reported that BMC is still negotiating with AIG to purchase the properties back.

BMSA Financial Committee

July 19, 2016 Report on Financial Documents

For June 2016

Operating Accounts

June is the 6th month of our fiscal year and everything continues to look good and there is nothing out of ordinary. We continue to remain in a very positive position. Copies of the June 2016 financials are included in your packets. The Financial Committee has reviewed these documents and we find them to be complete and accurate but subject to audit.

On the income side, the results show that income exceeded budget amounts by \$4,664. The Developer assessments underran the budget by some \$5,223; income from attorney fees exceeded the budget by some \$7857; and Comcast Franchise payments continue its drop underrunning the budget by \$3,071.

On the expense side, the actuals are lower than budgeted amounts (\$61,242) with most accounts being under budget except for the Community Relations because of the cost of printing the Annual Report, Common Area Insurance (\$1,056), Legal (\$1,309), Postage/Office Supplies (\$2,054), Fence Maintenance (\$2,088), and Utility Locates (\$1,769). These overages were balanced by many accounts being under budget, namely the maintenance items, some of which just haven't been billed yet. Therefore the reflected income over expenses will not be as much.

The bottom line shows a net positive amount of \$65,906 but bear in mind the maintenance items mentioned above will change this. If this the trend continues, we should end up in a positive position at the end of the year.

On the Balance Sheet, all of the accounts are consistent with past history and there is nothing of concern, however as explained by our accountant, the Accounts Receivable Assessments appear high but as mentioned not of concern.

Reserve Accounts

We also reviewed the Reserve Accounts. The Median Improvement account is over budget, Land Improvements not yet completed therefore showing an underrun of \$88,598, but the Waterfall Improvements (the pump replacement) was not budgeted but costs to date \$7,931.

The amounts invested with Edward Jones continue to earn small amounts and are consistent with the State Laws requiring investing in secure accounts.

The Annual Federal and State Income Tax Returns have been filed for 2015. Copies for the Board are available. Since BMSA is classified as a Non-profit Corporation, taxes were only paid on non-direct income items such as Interest.

The AGNC last met in Steamboat Springs, Colorado on Wednesday, June 22, 2016. The meeting was especially well attended.



<u>Turkey Trail Park:</u> I attended the Garfield County Planning Commission meeting on July 13th where the Planning Commission held a hearing to consider the BMSA's land use permit application to allow the development of Turkey Trail Park at 8935 County Road 300. The Planning Commission unanimously approved the land use permit. I will be coordinating with the contractor, Ted Ciavonne, to prepare request for bid proposals.

BMSA Waterfall: We ran into some delays with the installation of the two new pumps at the waterfall due to some scheduling conflicts with the contractor. New valves and fittings were ordered due to the differences in the design of the new pumps and the plumbing will also be modified to insure efficient operation of the pumps. Installation of the new pumps is scheduled to begin July 21st.

Right-of-Way Mowing: The 3rd mowing of the right-of-ways is to begin July 17th. The growing season for much of the native grasses is over but the alpha-alpha continues to grow in many areas and is the primary reason for mowing these areas again.

<u>Weed Management:</u> The second application of weed spraying on the right-of-ways was completed this past month.

Maintenance items: Additional fence repairs were complete along Monument Trail as broken posts and damaged pickets were replaced. Fences in the Big Park located in the Saddleback and Tamarack Villages were repaired at the back yards of E. Carson, W. Silverbelle and Little Echo where sections of the fence had been knocked down. The community yard sign near the cemetery was repaired after being struck by a vehicle and all of the posts were broken off and had to be replaced. The street sign at the River Bluff Road and Battlement Parkway intersection was repaired after a vehicle hit the sign and broke the post off. One of the park benches that was vandalized in the Big Park was repaired and new stain applied. Weed spraying was completed on the edges of the new landscaped medians and the gravel surface on Spencer Trail.
