

**RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
BATTLEMENT MESA SERVICE ASSOCIATION  
ADOPTING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES  
REGARDING DISPLAY OF THE AMERICAN FLAG**

- SUBJECT:** Adoption of a policy and procedure regarding the display of the American flag.
- PURPOSE:** To adopt a policy and procedure to be followed when a resident displays the American flag within Battlement Mesa P.U.D.
- AUTHORITY:** The Declaration, Bylaws and Articles of the Association and Colorado law.
- EFFECTIVE:** January 1, 2006
- RESOLUTION:** The Association hereby adopts the following policy and procedure regarding the display of the American flag within Battlement Mesa P.U.D.:

A resident may display the American flag provided it is on residence property or in a window of the residence, if the American flag is displayed in a manner consistent with the federal flag code, P.L. 94-344; 90 Stat. 810; 4U.S.C.4 to 10.

The American flag cannot exceed 4 feet by 6 feet in size.

Resident may also display a service flag bearing a star denoting the service of the resident or a member of the resident's immediate family in the active or reserve military service of the United States during a time of war or armed conflict, on the inside of a window or door of the residence. The service flags may not exceed nine inches by sixteen inches.

Flagpole requirements:

- (a) The flagpole may not exceed 20 feet in height.
- (b) Resident may place the flagpole in front or back yard location provided the Landscape Architect Committee approves the location prior to installation.

**Flag Etiquette**

The flag of the United States, for purposes of the chapter, shall be defined according to Title 4, United States Code, Chapter 1, Section 1 and Section 2, and Executive Order 10834 issued pursuant thereto.
