Call

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Stone Ridge Delegate, Keith Sheppelman.

Notice

Director Sheppelman established the notice of the meeting was sent out in compliance with the Association Documents.

Quorum

A quorum was established with 16 lots represented, 8 in person and 8 by proxy.

Approval of Minutes

Financial Reports

Tax Resolution

Open Discussion

Delegate Sheppelman reported that BMSA purchased 2.6 acres of property at 8935 County Road 300, Parachute. The property was obtained through a bid process for \$45,000. The existing structures will be removed and the property will be cleared of all dead trees and brush in 2012. The Board of Directors are discussing potential improvements to the property.

Jerry Mohrlang stated that there is a Community Conversation Meeting on the 2nd Wednesday of every month at the Library and 7:00 pm.

Mr. Mohrlang stated that Dr. Bruce Richards is having an End of Life Decisions discussion at the BMAC on November 14 at 7:00 pm.

Delegate Sheppelman reported that the Library Trail is near completion. There is some cleanup work that needs to be completed and there is some gravel that needs to be added to the soft trail portion of the trail.

Delegate Sheppelman reported that there are new community maps available at the Battlement Mesa Metropolitan District office.

Delegate Sheppelman reported that as of September 2012 there were 29 covenant violations for Stone Ridge Village. 8 were for maintenance issues, 9 for vehicle violations, 4 for trash carts left out, 4 for illegal signs and 4 for unsightliness.
